PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING BEFORE SIGNING

We make every attempt to provide a safe, clean, and disease free environment for any pet that comes to our clinic. However, just as with humans, there are contagious illnesses such as airborne upper respiratory diseases that may be hard to prevent completely when pets are in an enclosed environment with other pets. We do our best to minimize the risks by ensuring that boarding pets are current on vaccinations and by using kennel approved disinfectants known to have virucidal, bactericidal, and fungicidal properties.

Also, it is not uncommon for pets to experience stress or become ill while boarding. In those cases, we will treat them accordingly. This would include but not be limited to medications or special dietary food.

As part of our efforts to provide a good boarding environment we also require that pets be free of external parasites such as fleas and ticks. If any are found on pets upon entry they are treated appropriately.

****Unless stated otherwise please note that should your pet need medical attention while boarding we would initiate the necessary treatments. If the cost were to exceed \$100 we would make every attempt to contact you first at the emergency contact number you provide us.**

BOARDING POLICY

Thank you for choosing to board your pet at our clinic. Our facilities and policies are designed for the well-being of your pet and with your help we can make it a good boarding experience.

1. We require all dogs and cats to be current on vaccinations. Dogs must have had a 6-in-1 and a kennel cough vaccine within the last 12 months; cats must have had a 4-in-1 within the last 12 months. Both dogs and cats must have had their rabies vaccine within the last 3 years with a 3-year approved vaccine or within the last 12 months with a 1-year approved vaccine.
2. Pets are admitted and dismissed ONLY during regular office hours which are Monday through Friday between 7:30am and 6:00pm & on Saturdays from 8:30am to noon. Because of past unfortunate experiences pets will NOT be released after hours or during holidays.
3. We prefer that only minimum and non-valuable bedding or toys (one of each) be left with your pet. We are not responsible for those items as they may become soiled, lost or damaged by the pet.
4. Do bring any necessary medications so that we may continue giving them to your pet while he or she is boarding.
5. We feed Science Diet brand dry dog and cat food. Unless there are special feeding instructions mature dogs are fed once a day, puppies are fed twice a day and cats are free-fed dry food. If you prefer that your pet remain on the same food being fed at home please bring it when the pet is dropped off for boarding.
6. Dogs are walked three times a day.
7. The boarding facilities are cleaned and disinfected as needed throughout the day.
8. Fees that may be added to boarding charges or incurred as a result of being in a boarding facility:
 - a. a bath and/or flea or tick treatment should your pet have fleas or ticks upon entry
 - b. medical fees should your pet become ill while boarding or as a result of boarding
 - c. any special food that we deem necessary due to lack of appetite or illness while boarding
9. Should your pet stay with us seven days or longer we will give a complimentary bath the morning they are scheduled to leave. Plan to pick up your pet after 3:00pm.
